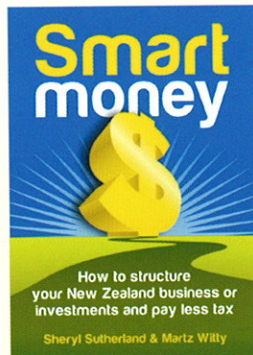


Freefall

This inspiring book by one of the world's leading economic thinkers details the course of the financial crisis that began in 2007. Nobel Prize winning author Joseph Stiglitz examines the underlying causes and shows why much more radical reforms are needed than those currently being considered, if we are to avoid similar systemic crises in the future. The book outlines the enormous opportunity – not yet taken – to design a new global financial architecture. It also shows why the bulk of the cost of the recovery should be borne by those in the financial sector – not just for reasons of natural justice, but also

for compelling economic reasons. Readers will be enthralled - and reminded to think about the human purposes economies are supposed to serve. **bt**

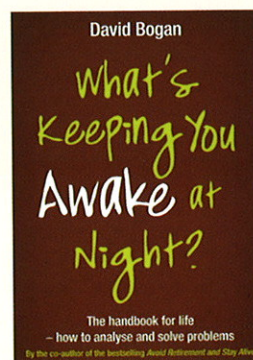


Smart Money
